How to find us

From M62/A63

- Follow the M62 East which turns into the A63
- Head towards the town centre on the A63 heading over Myton Bridge near the "Tidal Barrier/The Deep Aquarium"
- Take the first exit through the first set of traffic lights, turn right at the second set of traffic lights on to Clarence Street
- At the next set of lights continue straight ahead on to Dansom Lane **South** (do not turn right on to Holderness Road)
- Reckitt is located at the bottom of Dansom Lane South
- **Please note – Dansom Lane North does not have access to Reckitt, Hull Campus**

Safety and Security

On Arrival/Departure: All visitors are required sign-in at the Science and Innovation Centre Reception. At the end of each day visitors are required to return their access pass to the reception staff and repeat the check-in process the following day. Wherein a visitor fails to return an access pass at the end of the day – the pass will be deactivated at midnight and the host will be informed that their visitor is still in the building. It is a security requirement that all visitors, and employees, ensure that their pass is always clearly visible.

Fire-Alarms: Your host will make you aware if there are any planned fire-alarms during your visit. If the alarm does sound and you have not been made aware of any planned fire-alarms, please exit the building using the nearest stairs and follow your host to the muster-point (main car-park)

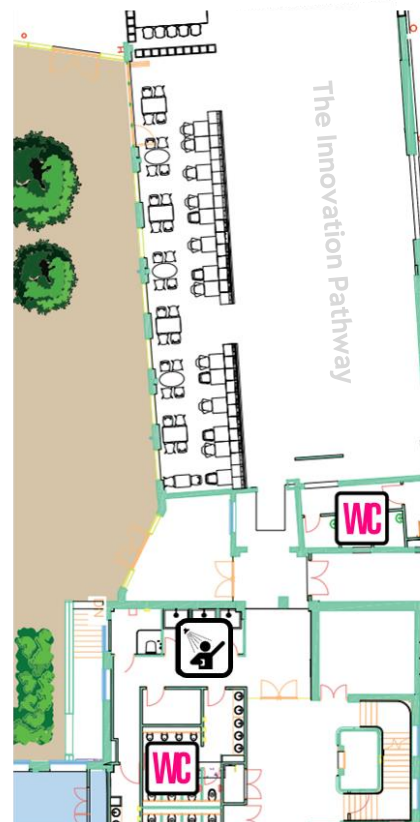

During your visit
